Subject : Request for extension of support and participation in the Nation Wide Protest Day on 3rd July 2020.

Dear Comrade,

You are aware that the major Central Trade Unions including AITUC, HMS, CITU, INTUC, LPF & Independent Federations like AIDEF are observing 3rd July 2020 as a Nation Wide Protest Day against the aggressive Anti labour decision being implemented by the present Government. AIDEF and INDWF will be observing this Programme in all the Defence Establishments. Since we are jointly fighting against the Anti Labour policies of the Govt. in Defence, you are requested to extend the support and participate in the programme as a mark of solidarity. We request you to kindly advise your affiliated Unions in this regard. The demands are given below:

- 1) No corporatization of Ordnance Factories.
 - 2) No GOCO Model in EME workshops and Depots under DGOS.
 - 3) No abolition of posts in MES and Army Units.
 - 4) No privatisation/outsourcing and FDI in Defence.
 - 5) No reduction of man power in DGQA in the name of rationalisation.
 - 6) No outsourcing and abolition of posts in Navy.
 - 7) No outsourcing in DRDO and regularise all Casual and Outsourced employees.
 - 8) Settle all the pending demands of Employees of Ordnance Factories, DRDO, MES, Navy and DGQA.
 - 9) Withdraw of NPS
 - 10) No dilution of Labour Laws.
 - 11) No DA/DR freeze.
 - 12) Settle the revised intergrade ratio for Artisan Staff (Tradesman), DRTC review of DRDO, Cadre restructuring of all Directorates etc.
 - 13) No Privatisation and disinvestment of Public Sectors undertakings.
 - 14) No closure of Govt. Departments and fill up all the posts laying vacant in all the Government Departments including Defence
- Awaiting for your favourable response.
