**Desperate MoD/DDP behaves in an unfair manner about our Indefinite Strike**

They have gone to the extent of asking retired Army Generals to write and publish Articles with false and fabricated information's to damage the image of the Ordnance Factories in the eyes of public.*** The latest unfair action taken by the DDP is to issue a letter dated 01/10/2020 to the three Federations and then circulating the same to social media to create confusion amongst the Defence Employees. The authorities who ever is doing this in MoD is not aware that these type of unfair and shameless activities will be completely ignored and rejected by the Defence

Civilian Employees, who are well aware of the conspiracy behind all these activities of the Government. The Federations are drafting a befitting reply and we are also thinking of legal action on all these unfair activities of the DDP. We are not fighting for any wage increase or any additional service benefits, our fight is to save the liquidation of our great Ordnance Factories.
