In the meeting officials concerned responded on the issues raised in the meeting and apprised on the status of the issues.

But further action/ progress on some of the issues and current status of them have not been informed as mentioned under-

Point No. 2(a) GOCO Model in ABWs, COD Kanpur and other Depots

It is learnt that GOCO Model is being implemented in 506 ABW Delhi but no road map has been shared with this federation as to how interest of employees will be protected. Similarly, Kindly apprise as to how the interest of employees in Ord Depot Shakurbasti, CVD Delhi, COD Chheoki Allahabad and VD Panagarh are being protected as these depots are under the disbandment process.

Point No. 2(c) Framing of Recruitment Rules and Cadre Restructuring of all categories

Kindly apprise the current status of Cadre Review proposals in respect of Clerical Cadre, Fire Fighting Staff, Store Keeping Staff, Cook etc

Point No. 2(d) Filling up vacancies in MCM which is pending from 2005 onwards-

It was appraised in the meeting that case for one time relaxation of Recruitment Rules for promotion of eligible candidates to the post of MCM is under process. But incumbents are still awaiting for their promotion.


Point No. 2(g) Arbitrary decision such as conversion of Cadres into Centrally Controlled

JS(AF) assured that effort to harmonise organisational interest and welfare of the employees shall be made. Almost all the unions affiliated to this federation have submitted a memorandum to DGOS to withdraw the instruction on conversion from locally controlled to centrally controlled civilian employees
